PMTC, KRTS and Transrep celebrate 2nd graduating class of the “Driven to Lead” Program

The Private Motor Truck Council of Canada honoured the Graduates of the 2nd ever Driven to Lead Program in a virtual ceremony that was part of their Annual Conference on June 17th.

“The Driven to Lead Program was born as a result of the PMTC Young Leaders group desire to provide its members, and the industry, with a practical, educational program that would help further their development and help them become more successful not only at work, but in their personal endeavors. Although the program was born from the ideas of our Young Leaders, the program is valuable for any individual, at any age.”, said PMTC President Mike Millian. “We are very grateful to our title sponsor of this program, KRTS and Transrep, their support of this program and the future of our Industry is second to none” Millian went on to say.

The Driven to Lead Program is an experiential, four-day module that took participants through hands on impactful exercises that focused on topics such as culture, teamwork, accountability, and Strategy. The Program began on March 11th and 12th, of 2020 with 16 people in attendance. Finally, restrictions eased enough that on September 22nd and 23rd modules 3 and 4 were able to be completed in person for 9 people who wished to attend, while 7 people attended modules 3 and/or 4 in a modified virtual format on October 13th and 14th. While we all wondered how this highly experiential course would work in a virtual environment, reviews that came in all indicated Jeremy did an amazing job transitioning in the trying times. The PMTC YLG is grateful for the great work Jeremy and the Eagles Flight team did in providing options for course completion that kept everyone’s health and safety, and personal comfort levels in mind. Certificates of completion were given out to all those who successfully completed each individual module, and as a result of Covid, graduation diplomas were mailed to all those participants who were able to commit the time and energy needed to attend and complete all 4 modules, therefore graduating from the entire program.
