Our Goals

TO PROMOTE SAFETY IN PRIVATE TRUCKING:

Workplace Safety:

To seek a safe environment in the workplace.

Vehicular Design:

To foster improvements in vehicle design and maintenance.

Training:

To ensure adequate standards of training and qualification for drivers and other operational personnel.

- To pursue improvements in highway design and regulations regarding optimum speeds, vehicle weights, bridge structure, crossing safety, etc.

- To recommend improvements in the occupational health environment for operational personnel.

RICK AUSTIN MEMORIAL DISPATCHER OF THE YEAR AWARD

Created in the memory of Rick Austin, this award recognizes a dispatcher who has made an outstanding contribution to their employer, contributed to the development and improvement of fleet safety and efficiency, has an excellent rapport with the drivers, and promotes the fleets core values to the drivers.

PMTC YOUNG LEADERS EDUCATION BURSARY AWARD – Sponsored by Tenstreet

PMTC LOGISTICS MANAGEMENT CERTIFICATION PROGRAM


The PMTC Logistics Management Certification Program will be awarded when all 4 of the courses below have been completed. The courses must be taken in the order that they are listed. Anyone who is an employee, or a child of an employee, is eligible to sign up for the courses through CITT at any time. The PMTC Logistics Management Certification Diploma will be awarded once proof of all 4 courses being completed and passed is presented to PMTC, and verified by CITT.

PMTC & KRIS PROFESSIONAL COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE DRIVER TRAINING SCHOLARSHIP

This program is an intensive minimum 200 hour course, which when completed, will arm the new Professional Driver with a high level of training, as set by the Professional Truck Driver Institute (PTDI) and the Truck Training Schools Associate of Ontario (TTSAO) mandatory requirements. These standards will provide the student with the skills and confidence necessary to become a successful Professional driver. The award will help promote investment in the training needs of our great industry.

Education Bursaries

YOUNG LEADERS EDUCATION BURSARY

Sponsored by Tenstreet

PMTC, in conjunction with CITT, each year awards up to two eligible PMTC members over \$1800.00 each in funding to complete the “PMTC Logistics Management Graduate Program”.

This will cover the cost for two of the four courses required to complete the course. Students have the option to complete the other two at any time, and will be awarded a diploma from PMTC when completed.

PMTC –KRTS PROFESSIONAL COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE DRIVER TRAINING SCHOLARSHIP

PMTC and KRTS award a PMTC member with a Professional Commercial Motor Vehicle Driver Training Scholarship which will cover the costs for the recipient to complete a full training program through KRTS, or another registered training provider should the candidate be from outside of Ontario.

Membership Categories & Fees

ANNUAL FEES ARE DETERMINED BY CATEGORY OF MEMBERSHIP:



PRINCIPAL MEMBER

Individual, partnership or corporation (“Entity”) which distributes or transports its own property by private motor truck either as owner or lessee thereof as incidental to or in furtherance of its principal commercial enterprise. Principal membership shall include those individuals, partnerships or corporations, a major part of whose business is the leasing of trucks, trailers or drivers, or providing dedicated transportation or logistics services to other principal members or to the broader trucking industry. Those who move products or supply services for others through use of a Commercial Motor Vehicle shall also be considered a Principal Member. Each Principal Member Entity shall be entitled to receive notice of, attend and vote at all meetings of the members of the Corporation. The term of membership for Principal Membership for the Entity shall be one (1) year, subject to renewal in accordance with the policies of the Corporation.

Base rate \$85.00 + hst per truck, trailer or driver , Minimum: \$500 + hst - Maximum \$1,890 + hst

ASSOCIATE MEMBER

Entity or corporation which has an interest in or a relationship to the PMTC but is not otherwise qualified as a Principal Member Entity. Each Associate Member Entity shall be entitled to receive notice of, attend and vote at all meetings of the members of the Corporation. The term of membership for Associate Membership shall be one (1) year, subject to renewal in accordance with the policies of the Corporation.

\$1,170 + hst

ADDITIONAL MEMBER

Members may elect to apply for one or more additional memberships each of which shall be entitled to the rights, responsibilities and privileges pertaining to their membership classification. Each member company shall designate one official representative (and any additional members) who, on payment of annual dues, shall receive mailings from the Corporation. **\$245 + hst**

YOUNG LEADERS GROUP MEMBER

Members may elect to apply for a young industry professional under the age of 40, who would assist the Board with creating events that would be of interest to a younger demographic, and to openly discuss career path, mentoring, and other subjects of interest to this particular group. **\$130 + hst**
